How to use: The document is filtered by deadline. If the deadline is coming up it is at the top (beginning) of the document. Also, if the scholarship requires a GPA it is noted in the GPA column. Most importantly, the last column of the document attempts to distinguish the scholarships between 5 different requirement categories. These categories are DACA eligible students, High School Students (HS), Undergraduate Students (UG) Graduate Students (GS) and Special Requirement (SR). The special requirement simply means that there is a specific requirement besides the ones mentioned above that needs to be met in order to qualify.

* When this guide was being made this scholarship was not updated and did not have a deadline. To make sure you don't miss any deadline, Like The [Keeping the Dream Alive](#) Facebook page to stay up to date when we receive these updates.

** These scholarships have the same deadline every year. (i.e if the deadline is April 30, 2014 it will also be April 30th for the year 2015)

*** These scholarships deadline is always the last Friday of the respective month.

Note to users : This guide was created with the purpose of giving undocumented students several options of scholarships to apply to. When I was in high school the list of scholarships for undocumented students consisted of only 2 pages with very few scholarships to each page. If I remember correctly, it was about 10-12 scholarships total. With that said, I would have really appreciated having something like this when I was getting ready to apply to college and scholarships.
