This course is devoted to communication and thinking skills through the integrated study of language, literature and writing. Language study emphasizes sentence patterns, punctuation, spelling, vocabulary and usage. This class will focus on English basics. Phonemic awareness, building vocabulary, basic English grammar, and verb tenses will all be covered. Students registered for this class are either "New Comers" with little to no English proficiency and have not been WIDA tested, or students who have been WIDA tested and are considered NEP. If a student successfully completes this course and still tests NEP on the WIDA, they may be required to retake this class. The teacher may use his/her own discretion with students in this situation. The class is open to all grade levels.
